She currently works at Wilson College as the Director of Career Development and is coordinating speakers for the meetings.

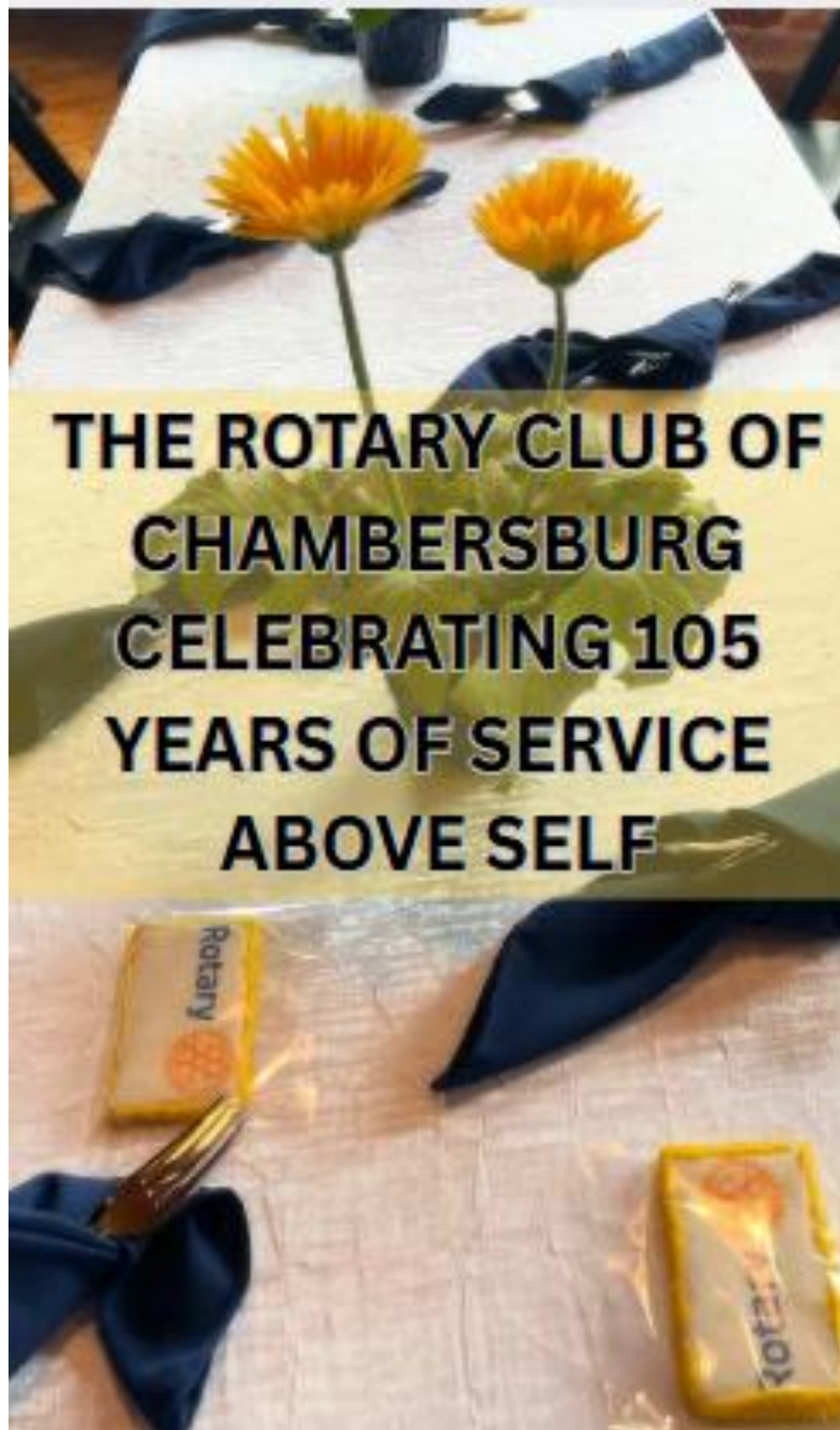


### **Clint Bolte**

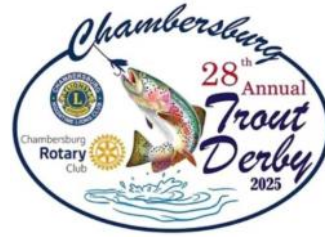
