His enthusiasm for the Polio Plus program led to his Paul Harris Fellow and the presenting of eight additional Paul Harris Fellows to relatives, Rotary members and friends, and also a Major Donor to The Rotary Foundation. The Ankerbrands have hosted a number of Rotary Exchange Students over the years as a "family member" in their home.

A native of Chambersburg and graduate of both CASHS and Penn State, class of 1964, Bob was transferred by his employer in York, PA to their District Sales office in San Francisco in January 1976, becoming District Manager in 1987 for the Western States and Western Canada as he traveled his territory and the world in his management job serving the top mining and engineering companies of the mining industry.

While in Foster City, Bob participated in many Rotary, Chamber of Commerce, and City of Foster City activities and projects for each organization, being honored as 1986 Volunteer of the Year and 1988 Citizen of the Year. Bob also served in1989 and 1990 as Chairman of the Celebrity Waiter event for the San Mateo, CA Chapter of the American Heart Association.

Bob was relocated by his company to Las Vegas, Nevada in October 1994 to continue his management and sales job as before to his many clients. He then moved back home to Chambersburg in October 2002, working again in the York office until his retirement in March 2003. He enjoys doing make-ups at other clubs, sporting events, theater, musical events, home projects, gardening, being around people, and spending time with his families and friends. He was honored to serve six terms from July 2011 to June 2017 on our Board of Directors, Past Chairman of the Valentine Candy Project, and past Chairman of the Membership Committee for the Rotary years of 2011-2012 and 2012-2013.

Members of this club may only make nominations, and information submitted will be held in strict confidence.


